

Master of Science in Athletic Training

Students interested in pursuing this program can obtain a Bachelor of Science in Health Management from Friends University and be pre-admitted to the University of Saint Mary Athletic Training program.

Students will need the following qualifications:

- Cumulative College GPA of 3.0 or greater
- Completion of 25 hours of observation under a Certified Athletic Trainer
- One letter of recommendation from a Certified Athletic Trainer
- Completion of the prescribed coursework

Students who want to enter this program will need to apply after having completed 60 credit hours at Friends University. Students selected will be required to interview at the University of Saint Mary. The University of Saint Mary will waive the application fees. Selected students will meet with a University of Saint Mary representative during their undergraduate career for academic advising and review of progress.
